315.23 There were no declarations of interest. Cllr Grice said that he was recording the meeting.

PUBLIC DISCUSSION PERIOD

316.23 It was agreed that Mrs Lewis would deliver letters from the Parish Council about parking in the vicinity of the H-bar to properties nearby.

ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR

317.23 It was proposed by Cllr Wilson that Cllr Burt continue in the Chair, seconded by Cllr Fry and passed unanimously. Cllr Fry proposed Cllr Wilson as Vice Chairman, seconded by Cllr Slack and passed unanimously.

VACANCIES FOR PARISH COUNCILLORS AND CO-OPTION OF NEW MEMBER

318.23 There are currently two vacancies for Parish Councillors which are being advertised through the usual channels. No new applications have been received.
